



ILLINOIS HISTORICAL VARIABLE RATES

Illinois Law requires suppliers provide access to a one-year price history for residential variable rate products. The chart below shows the average generation rates charged by ResCom Energy, LLC doing business as NextVOLT Energy over the past twelve months. Historical pricing is not indicative of present or future pricing.

As of June 1, 2024, the electric supply price to compare is currently 6.9 cents per kWh in ComEd. The utility electric supply price will expire on September 30, 2024. The electric utility electric supply price to compare does not include the purchased electricity adjustment factor. The purchased electricity adjustment factor August may range between +0.5 cents and -0.5 cents per kilowatt hour.
